The French Chemical Society - Île-de-France Section PhD Thesis Award 2022

Deadline for submission: May 31, 2022, midnight Paris time

In 2022, the Île-de-France Section of the French Chemical Society (SCF-IdF) is proud to organize the 6th edition of the SCF-IdF PhD thesis Award.

Six prizes in total of 650€ each will be awarded to young chemists for their work performed during their Ph.D in each of the following fields: "Organic chemistry", "Inorganic, Mineral and Materials Chemistry", "Theoretical, Physical or Analytical Chemistry".

Criteria for the application:

- The candidate must have defended her/his PhD thesis between January 1, 2021 and December 31, 2021.
- The candidate must have been enrolled in a doctoral school of Île-de-France region.
- The candidate must be a SCF member.

Details on how to apply:

The application **must be written in English** and contain the following items.

- 1) A cover letter stating clearly the reasons for the application to this award
- 2) A full CV (2 pages maximum), containing the full list of publications (articles, book chapters, abstracts, patents), and communications as presenting author (poster, conferences)
- 3) A summary of the PhD work (2 pages maximum),
- 4) A support letter from the PhD laboratory,
- 5) A copy of the PhD defense report,
- 6) The Excel file attached fulfilled,
- 7) A commitment of the candidate to freely present his PhD work at the Young Talented Chemists Day which will take place in September (date and modality virtual vs presence, to be defined).

Application forms have to be sent as a single PDF file (size < 2 MB) named "nameofthecandidate_JTCaward.pdf" by email to:

Deadline is set on May 31, 2022 midnight (Paris time). (Applications submitted later will not be eligible.)

<u>Timetable of the application procedure</u>:

- 1) End of application: May 31,2022
- 2) Evaluation of applications by the office of the SCF-IdF Section: after mid-June 2022
- 3) Selection and shortlist announcement: before end of June 2022 (no evaluation report will be provided)
- 4) Award competition in Paris during a SCF-IdF symposium in September (date and modality to be defined)
